2 Provision of the website (Logfiles)

2.1 Description and scope of data processing

When you access our website, even if you do not register or otherwise submit information, information of a general nature is automatically collected. This information (server log files) includes the type of web browser, the operating system used, the domain name of your Internet service provider, your IP address, referrer URL, date and time of access and similar.

They are processed in particular for the following purposes:

- (1) Ensuring a problem-free connection to the website,
- (2) Ensuring smooth use of our website, as well
- (3) Ensuring and evaluating system security and stability, in particular to detect misuse.
- (4) for the technically error-free presentation and optimization of our website.

The data is also stored in the log files of our system. This data is not stored together with other personal data of the user. We do not use your data to draw conclusions about you personally. However, we reserve the right to subsequently check the server log files if there are concrete indications of illegal use.

2.2 Recipients of the data

We use service providers to operate and maintain our website, who act as our order processors. All service providers are contractually obliged to treat your data confidentially.

3 Contact us

3.1 Description and scope of data processing

There is a contact form on our website that can be used to contact us electronically. If you take advantage of this option, the personal data entered in the input mask will be transmitted to us and stored. The sole purpose of processing your personal data is to process your request

At the time the message is sent, the following data will also be transmitted and stored:

- (1) Date and time of the request
- (2) URL from which the request was made
- (3) IP address

Alternatively, you can contact us using the email addresses provided. In this case, the user's personal data transmitted with the email will be stored. These include:

- (4) Date and time of the request
- (5) URL from which the request was made
- (6) IP-Address

as well as information about the servers involved in email communication.

You can also contact us using the telephone number provided. We collect log data that includes your telephone number and the duration of the conversation. We generally do not record conversations.

3.2 Recipients of the data

Our website is maintained by service providers who act as our processors. If you send us an inquiry regarding an offer, service providers we use may receive data for these purposes if they need the data to fulfill their respective service (e.g. IT services, call centers). All service providers are contractually obliged to treat your data confidentially.

4 Newsletters

4.1 Description and scope of data processing

Your data will be used exclusively to send you the newsletter you subscribed to by email and, if you have also given your consent, to evaluate how you use the newsletter and any content linked to it. Your name is provided so that we can address you personally in the newsletter and, if necessary, identify you if you want to exercise your rights as a data subject.

In order to check that a registration is actually made by the owner of an email address, we use the "double opt-in" procedure (DOI procedure) when registering online. This means that following your newsletter registration you will receive an email in which you must confirm your newsletter registration by clicking on a link.

At the time of DOI confirmation, the following data will also be stored:

- (1) Place, date and time of registration
- (2) IP-Address
- (3) E-Mail-Address
- (4) If applicable Salutation, first name, last name

We use service providers who act as our order processors for shipping and evaluations. All service providers are contractually obliged to treat your data confidentially.

5 Use of cookies

5.1 Description and scope of data processing

A cookie is a small data set that is created when you visit a website and is temporarily stored on the user's system. If the server of this website is accessed again by this system, the browser sends the previously received cookie back to the server. The server can evaluate the information obtained through this procedure. In particular, cookies can make navigating a website easier.

Cookies help make a website usable by enabling basic functions such as page navigation and access to secure areas of the website.

5.2 Use of technically necessary cookies

Some functions of our website cannot be offered without the use of cookies. For this it is necessary that the browser is recognized even after a page change.

We use cookies for the following purposes:
